[Garysha Youngblood](#) 5-foot-7 G Berkeley (2012) CA Ballaz #2: Youngblood is a very good athlete who was able to get out in the open floor and get some easy points for the CA Ballaz, though she can improve on her half court scoring. Youngblood also brings versatility on the defensive end with her length and energy.

[Bernadette Fong](#) 6-foot-3 PF Liberty (2012) CA Ballaz #2: Fong was limited some against WVBA Silver due to foul trouble, but made an impact when she was in the game. Fong plays with good leverage on the post and does a very sound job of positioning herself at the point of attack. She also reads the shooter well in going after blocked shots and rebounds. Offensively, Fong works hard before getting the ball, which in turn gives her easy looks off the pass.

[Brittany Boyd](#) 5-foot-8 PG Berkeley (2011) CA Ballaz 1: With Cal head coach Joanne Boyle in the stands, Boyd turned in a very stellar performance in leading the Ballaz to a second round win. She was a dynamic scorer, especially in transition, and showed range on her jumper out to the three point line in finishing with 16 points. In leading the break, Boyd has a great burst to jump on the defense and the court vision to put the ball in a number of spots. Defensively, she is a solid help defender who plays the passing lanes very well, but can improve in having a consistent mindset in on-ball defense.

[Deanna Calhoun](#) 6-foot-3 C Albany (2011) CA Ballaz I: The USC commit is a good athlete and it really showed on the defensive end as USC head coach Michael Cooper looked on. Calhoun reacts well to the ball and is a clear shot blocking presence as well as a tough rebounder. She plays well in the open floor too with the next step being continual development of her offensive arsenal, especially in the half court.

[Elisha Davis](#) 5-foot-5 PG Berkeley (2012) CA Ballaz I: Only a 2012 prospect, Davis already shows strong leadership traits which will play into her development as a point guard. On Wednesday, she threw a number of "wow" passes and sees the court well while keeping a scorer's mentality. She has good range on her shot and a great burst to be a dynamic playmaker in the transition game.
