Lady Lions goin back to Cali

The Westlake Lady Lions cruised to a 40-25 win over Banneker on Feb. 13 thanks to freshman guard Sharnea Boykin who had 12 points and eight rebounds.

Boykin, or, as her coaches and teammates call her, 'Cali,' recently moved with her family to Atlanta from California.

Boykin said the change was difficult at first, but her teammates helped ease the transition.

"I was nervous, but then my teammates helped me step up," Boykin said. "They made it a lot easier."

When starting senior guard Gabrielle Johnson went down with an ACL tear, head coach Hilda Hankerson had to call on Boykin.

"She was a little nervous at first and wasn't stepping up," Hankerson said. "After about the fourth game she loosened up."

Hankerson said this was the first time she has ever trusted a freshman with the point guard position.

"I've had kids come in here and run the point their first year, but they were sophomores," Hankerson said. "We would have never allowed that. That tells you how well she has come in here and mastered the system."

The Lady Lions finished the regular season undefeated in their region, but Boykin said it was important that they not get ahead of themselves.

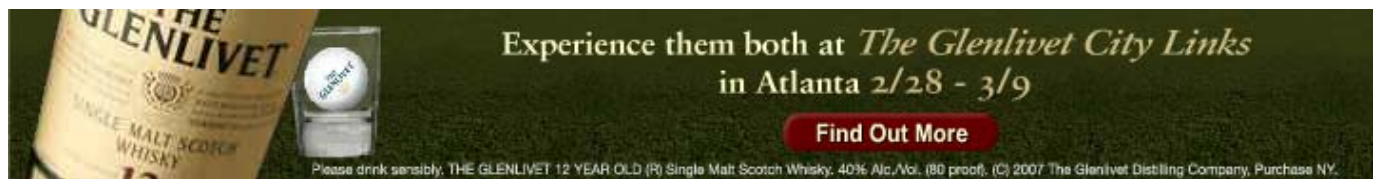
