WSU CAREER

SOPHOMORE (2009-10): Was one of seven Cougars to appear in each of the team's 30 2009-10 games...made 29 starts...was WSU's third-leading scorer at 10.9 points per game, a mark that ranked 20th in the Pacific-10 Conference...scored in double figures 16 times, including a game- and season-high 26 points against No. 2 Stanford (2/14/10)...also scored 20 points against Bradley 11/28/09), and now has four-career 20-point games...led or tied for the team high in scoring eight times...ranked 10th in the Pac-10 with 1.4 3-point field goals made per game...was second on the team in 3-point field goals made...among Cougars with more than 50 attempts, led the team in 3-point field goal percentage (.293)...made a career-high five 3-pointers against Oregon (3/5/10)...led the Cougars with 6.0 rebounds per game, a mark that ranked 15th in the Pac-10...also ranked 12th in the league in defensive rebounds (4.0 per game)...pulled down a career-high 13 rebounds against Boise State (11/29/09)...tied for the team high with three double-digit rebounding efforts on the season...led or tied for the team high in rebounding 12 times...recorded double-doubles against Saint Mary's (12/3/09) and Oregon (3/5/10), bringing her career total to three...second on the team in steals, ranking seventh in the conference with 1.9 per game...recorded a season-high five steals against both the Gaels and Arizona State (2/6/10)...led or tied for the team high in steals nine times...ranked second on the team in assists with 60 (2.0 per game), and led or tied for the team lead in the statistical category six times...recorded a season-high six assists against Oregon 1/3/10...had a block in 10 games...averaged 10.9 points, 6.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.9 steals in 26.9 minutes per game...named co-recipient of WSU's Top Coug award at the team's season-ending banquet.

FRESHMAN (2008-09): Started each of WSU's 30 games, more than any other Cougar freshman in school history...one of only two players to start every game in 2008-09 (Katie Appleton), and one of five Cougars to appear in each of WSU's games...named All-Pacific-10 Conference honorable mention, Pac-10 All-Freshman and Pac-10 All-Defensive honorable mention...scored 413 points on the season, more than any Cougar freshman in NCAA history...scoring average of 13.8 ppg is third on WSU's freshman NCAA list and ranked sixth in the Pac-10...scored in double figures 24 times, a WSU freshman NCAA record...scored in double figures in 12 consecutive games, the longest streak by a Cougar freshman in NCAA history...led WSU in scoring 15 times, tying for the team high with fellow freshman April Cook...led the Cougars in assists 11 times...led the team in steals 16 times...led WSU in rebounding six times...scored 28 points against Northern Colorado (11/28/08) in the odwalla Classic, tying the WSU NCAA freshman single-game record...named Most Valuable Player of the odwalla Classic...also scored 20-plus points against Oregon State (21; 1/15/09)...recorded her first career double-double with a team-high 17 points and a team- and career-high 10 rebounds against Arizona (1/31/09)...recorded a career-high seven assists against Long Beach State (12/5/08)...seven steals against Hawaii (12/22/08) tied the WSU NCAA freshman single-game record...first career multiple-block game came against Arizona in WSU's opening-round Pac-10 Tournament game (3/12/09)...holds WSU's freshman NCAA record for field goals (168) and field goal attempts (437)...both marks led the team in 2008-09...ranks second on WSU's NCAA freshman list in steals (63), also leading the team...2.1 steals per game ranked second in the Pac-10...ranks fourth on WSU's NCAA freshman assists list (78), a mark that led WSU in 2008-09...2.6 assists per game ranked 14th in the Pac-10...5.0 rebounds per game ranked 20th in the Pac-10, and 2.3 offensive rebounds per game ranked tied for 11th...1.3 3-point field goals per game ranked 13th in the conference...also ranks amongst WSU's NCAA freshman leaders in: minutes (2nd; 911), field goal percentage (10th; .384), 3-point field goals (7th; 39), 3-point field goal attempts (T-3rd; 137); free throw attempts (6th; 83), rebounds (T-6th; 149) and rebound average (T-8th; 5.0)...named co-recipient of WSU's Defensive Award at the team's season-ending banquet.

HIGH SCHOOL

Four-year letterwinner for head coach Cheryl Draper...team captain as a junior and senior...named all-conference second team and Street & Smith's All-America honorable mention as a FRESHMAN...once again named second-team all-conference as a SOPHOMORE...also garnered honorable mention All-America honors from Street & Smith's for the second-consecutive year...named second-team all-league as a JUNIOR...earned all-tournament honors at the Saint Mary Tournament...named Street & Smith's All-America once again...led squad to the Northern California championship game as a SENIOR...scored 28 points, pulled down 12 rebounds and recorded three steals and three blocks in the championship game...named Street & Smith's All-America and earned all-league honors after leading Berkeley to the league title...named most valuable player of the Division I NorCal Championships and earned third-team all-state all-division...also earned CalHSports Northern California Athlete of the Week accolades...played club basketball for the Bay Area Warriors, earning all-tournament, top 10 summer league and most valuable player honors.
